Code of Conduct for Athlete Members

Here at Coventry Godiva Harriers (CGH) we abide by the UKA and England Athletics Code and as a member of Coventry Godiva Harriers you are expected to abide by the following:

- All members will act with dignity and respect for all club members, coaches, team managers, technical officials, and Warwick University and Warwick Sport staff.
- Always thank coaches and officials who enable you to participate in athletics.
- Members will be responsible for their own needs including being organised, having the appropriate equipment and turning up on time to club sessions and events.
- Members should wear suitable kit and for Club competitions Club colours must be worn, as per UKA Rules for Competition, and these can be purchased from the Club.
- All members will ensure the payment of annual membership is made promptly (by 1st April) and if not a member that track/training fees are paid before the start of the session.
- All members must carry their Club membership card when attending training sessions and this must be shown at the University of Warwick and Warwick Sport reception in order to gain access to the track. Failure to do this may incur the need to pay the current entry rate to the University of Warwick.
- All members will understand the club rules about track and field discipline, and/or being out on the road or at other venues.
