Code of Conduct for Team Managers

Team Managers at Coventry Godiva Harriers are expected to abide by the [UKA Code of Conduct for Team Managers](#).

All Team Managers will act with dignity and respect for all club members and Warwick University and Warwick Sport staff.

As a responsible Team Manager you will:

- Place the health, welfare and safety of athletes above everything else.
- Be appropriately qualified and have an up-to-date DBS and have completed any relevant online safeguarding training.
- Behave with respect towards athletes, coaches, technical officials and others involved in the sport.
- Be fully prepared for your role as a Team Manager, at competitions and race meetings, including being punctual, ensuring coaches, officials, athletes and parents are aware times and venues of any competitions.
- Encourage all members to participate in any competitions and promote positive team spirit and behaviours.
- Maintain appropriate relationships and professional boundaries with athletes, especially those under the age of 18.
- Report any suspicion of misconduct to the Welfare Officer of Coventry Godiva Harriers or UKA as soon as possible.
- Abide by and support any regulations/guidance put in place by the University of Warwick and Warwick Sport when using facilities.
