Technical Officials at Coventry Godiva Harriers are expected to abide by the [UKA Code of Conduct for Technical Officials](#).

As a responsible Technical Official you will:

- Place the health, welfare and safety of the athlete above everything else.
- Be appropriately qualified and keeping up-to-date with your technical official knowledge and skills and adhering to all the terms of the UKA/England Athletics technical officials licence.
- Work within the limits of your technical official qualification.
- Act ethically, professionally and with integrity.
- Be fully prepared for officiating at a meeting, including being punctual, having the correct equipment and being appropriately dressed.
- Cooperate fully with other involved in the sport such as team managers, other coaches, and representatives of the governing body in the best interests of athletes.
- Apply the rules of competition fairly and in a spirit of goodwill to both athletes and fellow officials.
- Report any suspicion of misconduct to the Welfare Officer of Coventry Godiva Harriers or UKA as soon as possible.
- Abide by and support any regulations/guidance put in place by the University of Warwick and Warwick Sport when using their facilities.
